What is the Club?

- A community cricket club registered as a charity to promote participation in cricket playing and to advance the education of children and young people
- An inclusive organisation – girls, boys, women and men players are the beneficiaries, and all non-playing members help to achieve the charitable purposes
- A charity with a high reputation, in both cricketing circles and the local community, to protect and enhance

How is the Club run?

- By active volunteers – a sufficient number is essential to achieve success
- Volunteers focus on their specific areas of interest and skill, with the support of a small professional team, to ensure high quality facilities and services are provided for beneficiaries

How can you help?

- Become an active volunteer, either from time to time or on a regular basis
- Volunteering is open to non-players and senior players, and youth as a learning experience
- Offer *ad hoc* advice and guidance, particularly on ways of generating new income or developing better service delivery, based on your professional experience
- Obtain sponsorship or advertising income
- Be a regular umpire or scorer
- Assist qualified coaches with youth teams
- Senior players can help more in running cricket – be a volunteer as well as a beneficiary – and develop leadership skills
- Support social events and activities
- Support the Club as well as your child – become a ‘parent of Youth’ member
- Provide occasional evening car park patrols or help with car park supervision on rugby days
